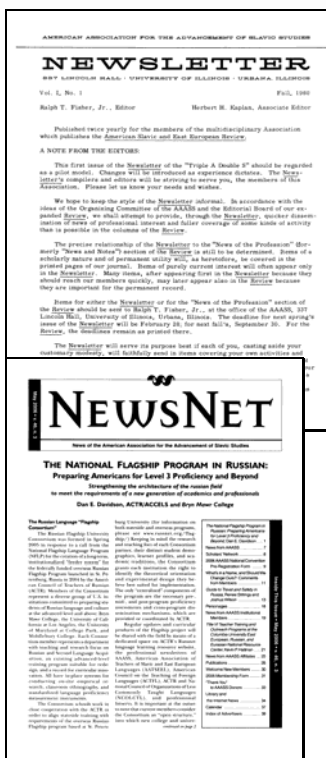
AAASS NewsNet Digital Archive is an online database which includes the complete backfiles of the newsmagazine of the American Association for the Advancement of Slavic Studies (AAASS) from 1960 to 2006. This is a repository of every page published in *NewsNet*. It may be the best electronic resource for documenting the evolution of Western scholarship in the fields of Slavic, Russian, Central European, and Eurasian studies.

The *AAASS NewsNet Digital Archive* provides a record of the research published in political science, history, language instruction and the humanities in the field. Use this resource to develop Festschriften or bibliographies of colleagues. For example, find discussions on Baranczak, Flier, or topics such as *Solidarność*, and announcements of new archival collections in the field. Other topics include:

- ◆ Language Proficiency: 'The National Flagship Program in Russian: Preparing Americans for Level 3 Proficiency and Beyond' by Dan Davidson (*NewsNet*, No. 3, Vol. 46, 2006, pages: 1-6).
- ◆ Major events of Soviet/East European history. Search 'Chernobyl' and a rich list of papers, presentations, research projects, and announcements of books written on the topic may be found.
- ◆ Articles of opinion, research and review essays: 'What's in a Name, and Should We Change Ours?' by Katherine Verdery, President of AAASS (*NewsNet*, No. 2, Vol. 46, 2006, pages: 1-4).

The retrospective enables users to follow trends, explore the foundations of current knowledge and track changing priorities in the field as reflected in AAASS annual conference agendas, papers, panels, and reports on research initiatives. Researchers may find evidence of the evolution of instructional programs, government grants, and the emphasis on particular topics of research.
